Christian Maurer

Christian Maurer (born 1967 in Ried i.L.) studied saxophone in Vienna from 1986 to 1993 with Oto Vrhovnik (classical) and Karl Kowarik (jazz), and attended masterclasses with Eugene Rousseau, Bob Berg and Steve Coleman. He has performed in concerts and CD productions with the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra, Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra, Vienna Radio Symphony Orchestra, and Klangforum Wien. As a soloist, he has appeared at the Vienna Konzerthaus and performed with ensembles including Varna Solisti (Bulgaria), the Vienna Chamber Orchestra, and the Erich Kleinschuster Quintet. His collaborations include Kenny Wheeler, Jack Walrath, Johnny Griffin, Adam Nussbaum, Liza Minnelli, Raul de Souza, Michael Gibbs, Natalie Cole, Bob Mintzer, Ed Neumeister, Joe Zawinul, Diane Schuur, Maria João, Don Alias, Don Thompson, Slide Hampton, Hans Koller, Manfred Weinberger (*Rhythm Fields*), Toshiko Akiyoshi, Mike Stern, Richard Galliano, Jane Monheit, and Randy Brecker.



Anna Maurer

Anna Maurer is a jazz pianist, singer, composer, and arranger from Upper Austria. She studied jazz piano at the University of Music and Performing Arts, the private university MUK in Vienna, and the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique et de Danse de Paris. Since 2021, she has taught piano, theory, and ensemble at the Landesmusikschulwerk JPR, currently working in St. Georgen im Attergau, Schwanenstadt, and Waizenkirchen. Alongside her teaching, she leads her own projects—the Anna Maurer Trio and the band Zweimaurer—and performs with various Latin and pop bands and orchestras, including the RSO, the Vienna Symphony Orchestra, and the Győr Philharmonic Orchestra.
